The Calgary Food Bank

Established in 1982, the Calgary Food Bank is a charitable, non-profit organization dedicated to gathering and distributing quality emergency food to those in need. The Calgary Food Bank distributed 262 Emergency Food Hampers per day in 2016, with 4 out of 10 clients being children.

Featured Program

Homeless Hampers

Homeless Hampers are distributed through community partners and provide two to three days of food for Calgarians with inadequate shelter. Hampers include nutritionally complete foods and ready-to-eat foods (pull-tab cans, heat and serve foods, or require only boiled water).

15,936 Homeless Hampers were distributed in 2016 through partner agencies.
